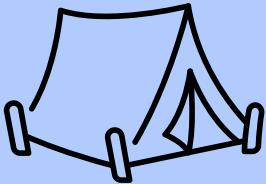


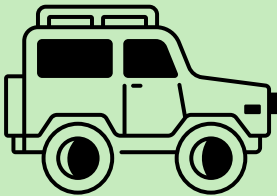
# Nature stories

Your teacher will allocate you one of the stories below to read. Your task is to work with your group to act out the correct response to the situation. Think about what rules exist to protect our local environment.



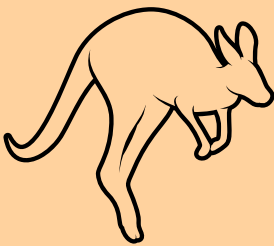
## Camping with family

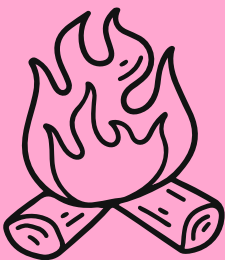
## 4WD adventure
