Rosa Parks

On December 1, 1955, Rosa Parks boarded a bus in Montgomery, Alabama. Instead of going to the back of the bus designated for African Americans, she sat in the front. When the bus started to fill up with white passengers, the bus driver asked Parks to move. She refused...Her actions were not without consequence. She was jailed for refusing to give up her seat.

"People always say that I didn't give up my seat because I was tired, but that isn't true. I was not tired physically, or no more tired than I usually was at the end of a working day. I was not old, although some people have an image of me as being old then. I was forty-two. No, the only tired I was, was tired of giving in."

In 1901 the Commonwealth of Australia was formed. Indigenous Australians were excluded from the census and the lawmaking powers of the Commonwealth Parliament.

Indigenous people were also excluded from the vote, pensions, employment in post offices, enlistment in Armed Forces, and maternity allowance.

Volleyball Uniforms

Norway's women's beach handball team has been fined for refusing to play in bikini bottoms during a game... The team wore thigh-length elastic shorts during their bronze medal match against Spain. The team was fined 1500 euros total (\$A2410) for "improper clothing,".

While male players are allowed to play in tank tops and shorts no longer than 10cm above the knee, women are required to wear midriff-baring tops and bikini bottoms "with a close fit and cut on an upward angle toward the top of the leg" and a maximum side width of 10cm, according to International Handball Federation regulations.


He gets picked last for a team every time, and the other kids have stopped passing the ball to him. He told the teacher he doesn't want to go to PE class anymore.
