

# Scenario cards

These cards include example scenarios of different types of racism experienced within sport.

## **Racist chant by spectators**

During an AFL game, a group of spectators begins chanting racial slurs directed at a First Nations player. The player hears the chants but continues playing.

## **Racial profiling by security**

At a major sporting event, security disproportionately stops and searches fans from minority backgrounds, assuming they are more likely to cause trouble.

## **Racist social media post**

A well-known athlete posts a racially insensitive meme on their social media account. The post receives backlash but also gains support from some followers.

## **Exclusion from team selection**

A multicultural teenager trying out for a local football team is told they "don't fit the team culture" due to their background, despite being highly skilled.

## **Racist graffiti at a club facility**

Racist graffiti is found on the walls of a sports club targeting players from minority backgrounds. The club delays addressing or removing the graffiti.

## **Casual racism in commentary**

During a live broadcast, a commentator refers to an African Australian player as "naturally athletic" while describing white players as "hardworking" and "intelligent."
