
Narrative Mapping: Like My Brother



Narrative Mapping Definitions	
Exposition	Where the narrative begins - the 'normal environment'.
Conflict	The problem or obstacle faced by the character/s, what drives the narrative forward.
Rising action	A series of events that build the tension and challenge the character/s, creating momentum.
Climax	The turning point for the story, usually a moment of tension and excitement. There can be a few climaxes across a story.
Falling action	Where the consequences of the climax play out, a time for reflection and understanding and an adjustment to a 'new normal'.
Resolution	Where the story comes to a and end and character arcs are concluded.
